MINUTES OF THE WEST VIRGINIA BOARD OF PHARMACY
CHARLESTON, WEST VIRGINIA, OCTOBER 10, 2018

President Lewis called the meeting to order and stated that a quorum was present. President Lewis further stated that proper notice of the meeting had been filed with the Secretary of State’s office. The meeting was opened with a prayer.

1. Motion was made by Board Member Bowyer to enter executive session. The motion was seconded by Board Member Kapourales. The motion passed unanimously without discussion.
2. Motion was made by Board Member Lewis to accept the final disciplinary orders for case numbers 2016-11-80 and 2017-01-05 as presented. The hearing examiner had found that the Board met its burden of proof by a preponderance of the evidence in each case. For 2016-11-80, Ms. Roberts shall be reprimanded, and her license shall be revoked without the ability to reapply. For 2017-01-05, Ms. McKinney shall be reprimanded, fined one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), and charged four thousand twenty-eight dollars (\$4,028.80) in administrative costs. The motion passed unanimously without discussion.
