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**MINUTES OF THE WEST VIRGINIA BOARD OF PHARMACY
CONTINUING PHARMACY EDUCATION COMMITTEE MEETING**

On Friday, August 22, 2025, the West Virginia Board of Pharmacy's Continuing Pharmacy Education Committee ("Committee") convened via video conference. The meeting was open to the public.

Committee Chair Duncan called the Meeting to order at 9:02 a.m. and recognized that a quorum of the Continuing Pharmacy Education Committee was present. Notice of the meeting was previously posted on the West Virginia Secretary of State's website. The agenda and video conference access information were previously posted on the Board's website and at the Board's office.

1. Mr. Duncan presented CE01 Jose Ricard Family and Sports Medicine Conference. It was noted that the provider's bios and objectives were provided. The committee reviewed the provided program and approved 14.31 hours for CPE including a 3.0 hr program that is related to drug diversion but does not meet the requirements of WV BOP drug diversion.
2. Mr. Duncan presented CE02 Lyme Disease-An Uptick in Hospitalizations. The committee reviewed provided materials and approved for 1.0 CPE hour.

3. Mr. Duncan presented CE03 Appalachian Addiction and Prescription Drug Abuse Conference. The Committee reviewed the materials provided and approved for 20 CPE hours. The program includes the following 3 sessions. "Clinical Complexities of Risk and Relief of Opioid Management: Navigating the Evidence, Ethics, Safety, and Guidelines of Opioids Prescribing" (90 minutes) "Legislative Update, WV Laws, Rules, and Regulations and the CSMP" (45 min) "WV Overdose Statistics Update" (60 minutes) if all 3 attended will be granted 3.25 CPE hours of Drug Diversion as the sessions together meet the requirements of statute and rule.
4. Mr. Duncan then opened the floor for any additional discussion or information the Committee might receive. No other information was received or discussed.
