MINUTES OF THE WEST VIRGINIA BOARD OF PHARMACY
February 12, 2026, LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE MEETING

On Thursday, February 12, 2026, the West Virginia Board of Pharmacy (“Board”) Legislative Committee convened a meeting to discuss current introduced legislation impacting the Board via videoconference. The meeting was open to the public.

DPRA Capehart called the meeting to order at 9:00a.m. Notice of the meeting was previously posted on the West Virginia Secretary of State’s, and the Board’s website and the agenda was made available at the Board’s office.

1. Director of Professional and Regulatory Affairs Krista Capehart presented a variety of bills that have been introduced thus far that are of interest to the Board including those relating to immunizations, dyes in pharmaceuticals, substance use disorders, BOP legislative rules, over-the-counter ivermectin, and credentialing. DPRA Capehart discussed her testimony in House Health RE: education on the drug approval process and dyes in pharmaceuticals. Additional bills discussing use of identifications, scheduling medications, telehealth and importation of drugs were discussed.

2. General discussion was held. No votes were taken.
3. The Board's Legislative Committee was updated on the transition to the Uniform MPJE and reviewed the documents to be submitted to NABP.
4. The next WVBP Legislative Committee meeting was scheduled for February 25, 2026, at 9 a.m.
5. The Legislative Committee adjourned at 9:55 a.m.
